Congregational Boundaries Advisory Group

Role: The role of the Congregational Boundaries Advisory Group ("Advisory Group") is to ensure that voices of individuals who have brought complaints of clergy sexual misconduct ("CSM"), and of individuals who have experience and professional background in the needs of congregations in the aftermath of CSM, are included in the ongoing work of the UUA Board Congregational Boundaries Working Group ("CBWG").

The CBWG will ask members of the Advisory Group, when relevant to their experience or professional background, to:

- **1.** Comment regarding proposed changes to the Ministerial Fellowship Committee Rules and Policies related to CSM complaints.
- **2.** Discuss with the CBWG what further needs for a national conversation about CSM may be (its goal and intent).
- **3.** Discuss with CBWG goals of review of accountability structure between the MFC and UUA Board and comment on review.
- 4. Participate in planning of GA workshops offered by CBWG in 2015 and 2016.

Members: The members of the Advisory Group may include:

- up to 2 individuals that have brought complaints of CSM.
- up to 2 members of Safety Net having either (1) experience in pastoral counseling victims/survivors of clergy sexual misconduct or congregations healing from clergy sexual misconduct, or (2) other professional background in counseling victims/ survivors of clergy sexual misconduct.

Members will be invited by the CBWG.
