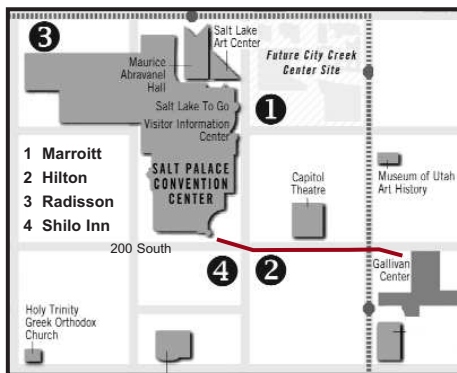
#3011 **Valuing ALL Families: An Interfaith Community Witness Event**
