The UUA General Assembly Planning Committee is committed to increasing the economic accessibility of GA. An important part of this endeavor is the program of matching grants available to individuals attending GA. These scholarship matching grants are intended to support congregations in sending their delegates and others for whom attendance is financially difficult. If this application is accepted, the Planning Committee will pay the applicant's GA registration fee and will also match a contribution from the applicant's congregation, up to \$250. (The congregation is free to seek funds from other sources, such as a district or affiliate organization, but the pledge and payment must come from the congregation.)

### Application Checklist

- One page statement from the applicant. The statement should explain why the applicant wants to attend GA and why financial assistance is being requested.
- One page letter of endorsement from the minister, DRE, or president of the congregation. This letter should verify that the applicant is an active member of the congregation. The endorsement should also explain why the congregation has selected this applicant as a delegate (if applicable).
- Written financial pledge of congregational scholarship/grant

If you have not already registered for GA, a GA Registration form must accompany this application. Please select one of the three options below.
