

UUA Pamphlet on UU Paganism: Request for Proposals

The UUA Pamphlet Team is pleased to announce a search for an editor of a new pamphlet about Unitarian Universalist Paganism..

As currently envisioned, this pamphlet will include statements from 3 or 4 individuals who identify as Pagan UUs or Unitarian Universalists with earth-centered theologies. Together, these statements should represent a spectrum of beliefs under the Pagan/earth-centered umbrella, including individuals who are inspired by pagan theologies from diverse cultures.

The editor of this pamphlet will be responsible for writing a very brief introduction to the pamphlet and for identifying, soliciting and editing the contributions, with prior approval from the project's developmental editor. The editor will receive a modest stipend of \$200 in appreciation for their work. Traditionally, pamphlets are a labor of love.

Your proposal should include the following:

- a cover letter stating your interest and qualifications for this work , along with your name and contact information
- a brief resume
- a writing sample
- a one-page description of the work, including your process for gathering and editing material; possible contributors; themes which you feel should be represented; any unique ideas you bring to the process.

Proposals are due: November 1, 2011
