Building the World We Dream About seeks to disrupt the workings of racism and transform how Unitarian Universalists from different racial/ethnic groups understand and relate to one another in our congregations and beyond. It provides 24 two-hour workshops and Taking It Home activities, reflections, and readings to do between meetings. The program creates opportunities for participants to develop antiracist, antioppressive, and multicultural habits and skills and to commit themselves to new, intentionally multiculturally competent and antiracist ways of being.
