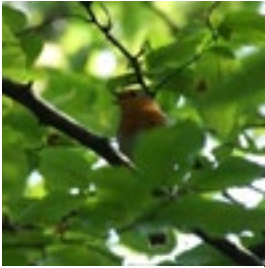

One Thing Going On

This Just In: Congregationally-Based Youth Observer Election!!

The Youth Observer to the UUA Board of Trustees is an important, national leadership position held by a UU youth, high-school aged or equivalent. The position serves on the Board in every capacity except voting rights.

The Youth Observer was previously nominated from and elected by General Assembly (GA) Youth Caucus, excluding all those youth who did not or could not attend GA. This year, the Youth Observer position has a new congregationally-based election process! All youth in UU congregations will be eligible to be a candidate for the position, as well as vote on the Youth Observer nominees. The voting process will require registration/confirmation of youth votes by a congregational leader (minister, religious educator, or president). Support our Troops during the Repeal of Don't Ask Don't Tell (DADT)



If your congregation is located near a military base, you might be looking for ways to outreach into the community. With only seven Active Duty UU Chaplains in our entire armed forces, there are many GLBT troops as well as others who could use the support of a nearby liberal religious community.
