New from Skinner House comes *From Zip Lines to Hosaphones: Reflections on the Search for Truth and Meaning*, a collection of essays from Rev. Jane Rzepka. Recently retired as minister of the Church of the Larger Fellowship, Rzepka presents her take on UU identity, history, and theology.

The book is a great source for sermons, and could be used in a variety of group settings in the congregation. Since it provides introductory material in a readable way, it would be ideal for New Member classes or as a gift for Coming of Age ceremonies. It could be a common text for adult RE classes or small-group ministry gatherings.

From Zip Lines to Hosaphones gives us all a new resource for talking about our faith tradition. More involved than *The Unitarian Universalist Pocket Guide* or *Welcome: A UU Primer*, it presents material in a more folksy style than *A Chosen Faith*. Check it out at the [UUA Bookstore](#).
