- Leigh Freidman **challenged us** to wear three hats at GA 2012: one as a guest in the city of Phoenix, one as an ally to the immigration justice advocates, and one as a peer in spiritual growth.
- Rev. Alicia Roxanne Forde offered **We Are Not Guests**, suggesting it is restitution, more than hospitality, our nation might offer immigrants.
- The Mid-South District offered a model for **multigenerational service learning**. Rev. John Tolley described **multigenerational worship** that joins “com-passion” (feeling with) to justice.

The purpose of the AUUA is to provide training and support for members; to be a clearing house for church administrative information; and to improve recognition of church administration as a profession.
