One Thing Going On

Intentional Professional Development for Religious Educators & Musicians

Well-equipped leaders are essential to thriving congregations. To enhance the perspective, skills, and theological understanding of our professional leaders, the UUA has developed credentialing programs for religious educators and musicians.

The **Religious Education Credentialing Program** provides a comprehensive path for professional development at three levels. To become credentialed, a religious educator demonstrates skill, knowledge, and practical application in 8 to 16 competencies that include Program Administration, Unitarian Universalist History, Right Relations, and Stewardship.

The three-year **Music Leadership Credentialing Program** summons music leaders to their calling of music ministry by focusing on foundational understandings in three main areas: Music Skills and Resources, Unitarian Universalist Heritage and Values, and Leadership and Interpersonal Skills.

When your program staff pursue a path of intentional professional development, they are being guided, challenged, and assessed in areas essential to their work. Your congregation will reap the benefits of their enriched leadership through more robust, innovative, and religiously grounded ministries.
