The expansion of the WorshipWeb continues with the addition of a new module devoted to Music in Worship. Here you will find links to resources that many of our congregations have found useful. One of the most exciting elements of the new Music module is the UU Composers' Database. Compiled in collaboration with the Unitarian Universalist Musicians' Network it is a listing of seventy working composers, noting the style(s) in which they work as well as contact information for them. There is a lot of great new UU music being created out there and this is a wonderful way to help it spread more widely.
