Public Role With the Transylvanian Youth

For a project to establish youth ministries within the Transylvania Unitarian Church, and to create a public awareness of Unitarian Youth through several public events including drama festivals, contests, and conferences.

\$7,000 **International Council Of Unitarian Universalists / Kalamazoo, MI**
Africa Task Force Leadership Training Conference

To support a four day leadership training conference to be held in Nairobi, Kenya, that will focus on organizational development, worship and religious education for emerging and developing Unitarian and UU groups in Africa.

ICUU Theological Symposium 2006

For a five day theological symposium, gathering U/U theologians from members and emerging groups of the ICUU to share and learn together about how our theological foundations are evolving in response to our world.

International Convocation of Unitarian and U.U. Women

For a convocation of Unitarian and UU women from around the globe to be held in New Orleans, strengthening connections and building support for women's rights worldwide.

Balazs Parish Field Experience in Transylvania

For a pilot U/UU reciprocal exchange program that will provide a seminary student a cultural immersion in Transylvania, with the goal of strengthening ties between U/UU in the US and Romania and provide insights to enhance Partner Church relationships.

Strengthening Local UU Congregations (SLUUC)

For a program to strengthen UU congregations with support from visiting ordained and lay workers in several areas of need including administrative, congregational planning, programming and identifying a sustainability project for the congregation's ministry.

To expand and strengthen the UU presence in urban Manila and at the University of the Philippines.
