## **Report On Proposed Actions Of Immediate Witness**

The Commission on Social Witness received 15 proposed Actions of Immediate Witness by the posting

deadline of 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 22, 2001. All of these proposed AIWs were timely filed by the deadline of 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 23. One was disqualified because it lacked the requisite number of supporting signatures.

The Commission was required under Bylaw Section 4.16(b)(2) to select six from the remaining 14 that comply with the requirements of Section 4.16(b)(1) to submit to the Agenda. No proposals were combined.

There will be a Mini-Assembly today at 5:00 p.m. on each of the six selected AIWs. The Mini-Assembly is the only chance to propose amendments to an AIW. Here are the selected AIWs and the schedule of rooms in the Convention Center for the Mini-Assemblies:
