

Sample Organizational Charts for Unitarian Universalist Congregations

Where does the stewardship team fit into your Unitarian Universalist congregation's organization? One way to determine this is to find a place for it in your organizational chart. This can clarify to whom the team reports and how it might relate to other groups in the congregation.

Below are three sample organizational charts – all very different from each other and all currently being used. What they have in common is that a stewardship team placement has been added to them. We recommend placing the stewardship team right under the governing body; as shown in the following charts.

Every congregation can have a unique organizational structure. Based on your own structure, where would your stewardship team fit? What placement can ensure the kind of coordination, stewardship visioning, and stewardship education that will help grow stewardship in your congregation? The following samples are just that - samples. They are intended to help you think about what will work in your congregation.
