Notes on the Service

The annual Service of the Living Tradition recognizes ministers who have been granted preliminary fellowship, achieved final fellowship, or completed full-time service; religious educators who have achieved, or are retiring from, credentialed religious educator status at the master or credentialed level; and certified music leaders. We also remember and honor those professional religious leaders who have died between May 16, 2016 and May 15, 2017.

The offering received today supports the Living Tradition Fund, which provides scholarships, debt-reduction grants, and financial assistance in times of need to seminarians, ministers, religious professionals, other congregational staff, and retired ministers and their loved ones.

The preacher for our service is The Rev. Cheryl M. Walker. The Reverend Cheryl Walker has served as the pastor of the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Wilmington since 2009. Prior to going to Wilmington, she served four years as the Assistant Minister at the Unitarian Church of All Souls in New York City.

Rev. Walker currently serves as the President of the Unitarian Universalist Ministers Association.

She holds a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Springfield College and a master of divinity from The Union Theological Seminary of New York. A native New Yorker, she currently resides in Wilmington, North Carolina, with her partner Elizabeth and their cat Hazel.

Music for the Service:

Our music director is DeReau Farrar. DeReau joined First Unitarian Church of Portland (Oregon) in July 2016 as Acting Director of Music. He was named permanent Director of Music in March 2017. Originally from Southern California, he served as Director of Music for the UU Community Church of Santa Monica, Choir Director for First Unitarian Church of Los Angeles, Artistic Director of Selah Gospel Choir—an interfaith community gospel choir, Voice and Choir Teacher for New Roads High School, and Musical Director for the classic theater company, A Noise Within.

Additionally, DeReau worked in Los Angeles as a freelance music director, vocal contractor, consultant, and arranger, and has a background as a classical singer.
