- Collaborate with other congregants and youth to lead a multigenerational United Nations Sunday service once per year.
- Participate in Youth Envoy conference calls, virtual training sessions, and networking events, connecting with other Envoys and Youth Envoys around the U.S. and Canada.
- Help the congregation to achieve Blue Ribbon Congregation status.
