### **New UU State Advocacy Networks**

Two new UU state advocacy networks formed this fall in Ohio and Maine bringing the total to fifteen UU state networks across the country. All the networks engage in outreach to identify issues of concern to congregations in their states and work in coalition with interfaith and advocacy groups to bring our UU voices and values to the public square. These vary from state to state, and change over time, but all the networks advocate for LGBTQ equality and most have an Immigration Task Force as well. Advocacy and organizing for environmental and economic justice are also priorities. Networks leaders collaborate with UUA Witness Ministries, Standing on the Side of Love Campaign, and District Staff and when opportunities arise nationally they all pull together.
