Got Teeth? Are you retiring?

Employees participating in the Office of Church Staff Finances' Group Insurance Dental Plan who retire this year and meet eligibility requirements may [apply to continue their existing dental coverage](#).

The retiring employee must:

- o be at least 62 years of age at retirement,
- o have a retirement date of 01-01-2013 or beyond,
- o have been enrolled in the Office of Church Staff Finances' Group Insurance Dental Plan on their last work day immediately preceding the date of retirement,
- o have worked a minimum of 750 hours for the employer and/or as a recognized community minister for at least 5 of the past 10 years,

Anti-Bullying Campaign

MTV has launched an anti-bullying campaign for the digital age called "A Thin Line." <http://www.athinline.org/>. The site is designed for teens, but also has resources for parents and educators who want to be of support. Here you can

find out about sexting, “constant texting” (that crosses the line into harassment), spying and stalking through digital media, digital disrespect, and just plain cruelty using social media or cell phones. Teens can share their stories, get immediate help, and even get free cool gear from MTV. You can also find links to their Facebook group (where there are daily posts with links to videos and other resources), a free app for smartphones, as well as A Thin Line’s Google + site, Twitter feed, and Yearbook site. 17% of young people have been manipulated or threatened on line or in a text. 50% of those who shared a “sext” shared it with multiple people. 29% of teens have had rumors spread about them on line or via text.
