Re-Visiting Selma

Join the Living Legacy Project for Marching in the Arc of Justice Re-Visiting Selma: A Conference Honoring the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Selma Voting Rights Campaign, March 5-8, 2015.

In early 1965, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference appealed to people across the United States to join in the struggle for voting rights in Selma. Many Unitarian Universalists answered the call, including President Dana Greeley and members of the UUA Board of Trustees. Fifty years later, March 5-8, 2015, UUs are gathering with others in Alabama, for a significant civic, political, and interfaith celebration.

Thousands of people from around the world will be converging on Selma, Alabama, March 2015, to commemorate the 50th Anniversary Bridge Crossing. Join the Living Legacy Project as we invite Unitarian Universalists to Selma to honor our martyrs, the Rev. James Reeb and Viola Liuzzo, and reflect with one another about what their courage and the courage of countless others require of us in 2015.

LOGISTICS and REGISTRATION

Re-Visiting Selma 2015 will begin and end in Birmingham, Alabama. The best airport to fly into is Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport (BHM). You will be responsible for transportation from the airport to the conference hotel and back, but all other transportation and meals will be included in the registration fee.

Registration for *Re-Visiting Selma* will open in the fourth quarter of 2014. Participants can register for the full conference or for individual days as your schedule allows. Along with registration, we'll also announce lodging options, including a special block of rooms available for conference attendees.

To experience the full Re-Visiting Selma 2015 event, plan to arrive on Wednesday, March 4th (or at least by noon on Thursday, March 5th) and plan to leave no earlier than Monday, March 9, 2015.
