




### The State of the Field in 1999




### The State of the Field in 2011










Percentage of Member Congregations that are...






### FBCO Member Congregations

Compared with All Congregations in the U.S.





### Average Number of Years of Involvement for Member Congregations by Religious Tradition






















### Income Composition of FBCO Board Members




### Immigrant Representation

Percentage of Member Institutions whose constituents are predominantly




### Immigrant Representation









### Primary Issues: highest engagement

Highest level at which FBCOs are addressing these issues:




# Thus, the Unitarian-Universalist movement serves as <u>leaven</u> within an important and dynamic terrain of democracy in America

2. Witness and push forward....


...but do not blow up the "reform coalition"

Internally: compelling worship & deep spirituality










#### Modes of Mass Communication
