VIRTUAL EXHIBIT SPACE TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The exhibitor agrees to provide a MasterCard, Visa or UUA Budget Code on the Exhibitor's Reservation Form to secure virtual exhibitor space, as well as for any incidental charges or damages that may occur during GA.
2. The exhibitor agrees to have their virtual exhibit booth set up by Tuesday, June 14, 2022. (You are more than welcome to set this up immediately, as well.)
3. Virtual exhibit space may be canceled with a \$100 cancellation fee up until April 15. Exhibitors canceling between April 16 and May 15 will receive a 50% refund of their payment. No refunds will be issued after May 16, 2022.
4. The UUA assumes no responsibility for destruction of, loss of, theft of, or damage to the exhibitor's intellectual property from any cause. Each exhibitor assumes all risks related to content shared online. Likewise, each exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the UUA from and against any and all liability and expenses arising from or out of the use by the exhibitor of the virtual exhibit space, or the exhibitor's activities in connection therewith.
5. The UUA encourages vendors to sell only fairly made and fairly traded merchandise. The UUA requests that the exhibitor, to the best of her or his ability, ascertain where and under what conditions the goods-for-sale were manufactured.
6. The UUA supports sharing of booth space for groups' representative of coalitions.
7. Subletting virtual exhibit space is NOT Permitted.
8. One name on booth display name one program description per booth
9. In the event that access to the virtual exhibit booth is prevented by an act of God, fire, strike, lockout, civil disturbance, government regulations or any other cause beyond the control of the UUA, the UUA shall not be held liable and may determine the amount of exhibit fees, if any, to be refunded.
10. The UUA is committed to becoming an anti-racist, anti-oppressive, multi-cultural faith community that also removes barriers to persons with disabilities. We seek to be as welcoming, inclusive, and respectful as possible of all people and cultures. We further acknowledge that each of us can only fully know our own experience. Exhibitors agree to be intentional about the content and communications used to engage GA attendees in order to avoid negative impact and harm.
11. The UUA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to dismiss, prohibit, or evict any exhibit or exhibitor.
12. The UUA shall have sole discretion in the interpretation and enforcement of all terms and conditions contained herein, and the power to make such amendment or further terms and conditions as deemed necessary for the proper conduct of this virtual gathering
13. Exhibitors agree to be respectful of the Whova community boards and refrain from posting "spam" messages. Additionally, exhibitors agree not to post in identity-based community groups, and to be respectful of the topic of community groups and how their posts relate to this.
