The service will be live-streamed and available after for on-demand viewing on [uua.org](http://uua.org) and YouTube.



## The In-person Experience

- There are about 60 UUA congregations and 10,000 UUs within a day's drive to Portland.
- 2022 will mark our first opportunity since 2019 to physically gather.
- The Exhibit Hall will bring together dozens of UU vendors and organizations.
- Talented UU musicians will provide live musical performances.
- Everyone will be vaccinated and masked.





# The Virtual Experience

- Apply lessons from 2020 and 2021
- Engagement of “off-site” (old terminology) delegates replaced with more equitable participation by both in-person and virtual
- Virtual Exhibit Hall
- Most workshops will be immediately available to virtual participants (a recorded version will be available after live workshops)
- UUA Board members will participate as both in-person and virtual participants
- Vaccination encouraged, but not required

# Virtual and In-Person Delegates

- Business-only delegate registration is available
- Allows congregations to choose delegates independent of ability to travel and pay for accommodations
- Bylaw change made in 2021
- Access to the delegate platform
- Expect new opportunities to consult with congregations while providing representation



# The Delegate Experience

- Prior to GA, forums will be available to the UU Community to comment on and discuss proposed business agenda items. This is open to the UU Community but does require users to create an account.
- Delegates can register for GA before or after they receive their voting credentials. Delegates can register as an in-person participant, a full-virtual participant, or a business-only virtual participant.
- Business sessions will be streamed on [uua.org](http://uua.org) and YouTube.
- Rather than live or instant polling, voting will be conducted via online ballot
- Delegates will have one hour after the end of General session to submit their ballots.
- The Delegate Platform will be accessible to all GA registrants who have delegate credentials.



# The Delegate Platform

The Delegate Platform will serve as the hub for quick access to resources such as the business agenda and text of any proposed amendments or business resolutions and will be mobile/tablet friendly.

Also available via the delegate platform:

- Dedicated chat room to discuss business with other delegates
- Links to ballots to vote on any items that came up during General Session
- Access to the General Session Zoom meeting, for virtual delegates who want to discuss business items
- Form for submitting proposed amendments to business agenda items



# General Sessions

- General Sessions will take place in Portland, Oregon, and online. Only registered delegates will be able to participate in the discussion.
- Anticipate making the in-person delegate experience equitable to the virtual delegate experience
- General Sessions will be live-streamed on [uua.org](http://uua.org).
- Delegates will be able to discuss business in chat rooms in the Delegate Platform.
- The Final Agenda and Rules of Procedure will be available at [uua.org/ga/program/business-agenda](http://uua.org/ga/program/business-agenda).



# Rules of Procedure Changes

- Rules in "Plain Language" – similar to 2021
- Adopt, then amend rules
- Information Room will
  - direct delegates to the right line
  - answer questions
  - alert Moderator when items need to be addressed



# Business Resolutions

- UUA Board anticipates only two business resolutions for this GA
  1. Endorsement of a strategy for bylaw changes
  2. Changes for the GAPC (General Assembly Planning Committee) -- adapt to the changing environment of GA
- Goal: To present these prior to GA and discuss via online forums prior to GA, so congregations are engaged



# Mini-Assemblies in 2022

After a Mini-Assembly and before voting in General Session, the Board may **incorporate proposed amendments** into a business resolution or a proposed bylaw amendment.

- The Mini-Assembly to review bylaw changes and business resolutions will be held via Zoom Webinar.
- Only delegates will be able to participate via Zoom.
- Zoom's polling feature will be used for voting during the session.
- Delegates wishing to speak will be able to do so with audio only.
- Zoom's Q&A feature will be enabled as well.
