Proposal: Change 33% to 50% in Bylaw Rule 4.18.5 (c) (2).

2464 (2)	Proposed amendments that receive support from at
2465	least 33% 50% of delegates voting in the mini-assembly will
2466	be added to the General Assembly final agenda. This
2467	support is based on the total number of delegates who
2468	vote for or against the proposed amendment, and does
2469	not include abstentions.

Rationale: Any proposed amendments to the rules of procedure or a business resolutions should get support from at least 50% of the delegates voting on the ballot from the mini-assembly. Generally, the mini-assembly attracts people who would like to offer amendments, so there may be a bias toward more amendments among those likely to vote. Further, a 50% threshold is consistent with democratic processes.
