

1. The first change, internal to the MFC, is a paragraph that would go in our "Checklist For MFC Interview Materials"

It currently reads:

Statements of Competence and Educational Resources Lists: The MFC expects candidates to create comprehensive educational resources lists and coursework—or equivalent substitutions—by the time of the interview. All are relevant areas of inquiry during the interview, regardless of whether the candidate has completed them. A candidate cannot qualify for preliminary fellowship until all statements of competence and the educational resources lists are completed.

The MFC (which has purview over this language) would change it to read:

Statements of Competence and Educational Resources Lists: The MFC expects candidates to create comprehensive educational resources lists and coursework, the sum of which will lead to and demonstrate their competency in each area. The resources listed must be fully understood, engaged with, and completed by the time of the interview. All are relevant areas of inquiry during the interview. A candidate cannot qualify for preliminary fellowship until all statements of competence and the items on the educational resources lists are met with deep engagement and completed.

2. And this is the new language for the rule change (which must be approved by the UUA Board).

Under Rule #11- General Qualifications, it currently reads **"have completed the required readings"**

We would like it to be changed to:

"have fully engaged with, understood, and completed all of the items in their self-created Educational Resource lists."

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
