Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) Board of Trustees' Policy on Board Participation During Contested UUA Moderator Elections

- 1. The Board, as an entity, may make statements to clarify which Moderator candidates support the direction and priorities of the Board, and which candidates do not.
- 2. The Board may make statements in support of the work of the Moderator Search Committee.
- 3. The Secretary of the Association shall remain neutral in any election.
- 4. The Co-Moderators of the UUA Board shall remain neutral with respect to individual candidates for UUA Moderator.
- 5. Individual Board members may choose to:
 - a. Remain neutral, or
 - b. Support candidate(s) by:
 - i. donating to one or more campaigns.
 - ii. sharing their support for a candidate in conversations with friends and colleagues, and with members of their own congregations.
 - iii. "liking" candidate statements on social media.
- 6. Board members who are not candidates shall refrain from:
 - a. allowing their image or statements of support to be used on a candidate's website, social media, or in any other campaign materials.
 - b. wearing t-shirts, buttons, or other campaign paraphernalia.
 - c. staffing a candidate's General Assembly booth, or handing out campaign literature at General Assembly or other Unitarian Universalist gatherings
