Common areas from participants' risk scenarios

Top scenarios

- Building damage/vandalism
- Cybersecurity
- Intrusions/Sunday services interruptions
- Finances (rising costs)

Other areas: emotional/spiritual fatigue, membership decline, government targeting, doxing, active shooters/physical violence

Enterprise – holistic, structured approach across the community

**Scenarios – situations
we imagine (grounding)**

**Assessment – thinking through
the impacts (clarifying)**

**Plan – ways to reduce
risk impacts (preparing)**
