


***Sing Out Love* has a new Steering Council!**

Donald Milton III (he/him) is a dynamic conductor, educator, and arts leader in Atlanta, GA who served the UU Congregation of Atlanta for 17 years. He is the Artistic Director of the Atlanta Gay Men’s Chorus (AGMC), one of the oldest and most celebrated LGBTQ+ choruses in the U.S., and the founder of SkyPunch ATL, a creative production company dedicated to immersive and innovative musical events. Donald is also a sought-after clinician and lecturer, specializing in vocal pedagogy and aging voices, and has presented workshops and masterclasses across the U.S. and internationally, including his acclaimed lecture *The Second Voice Change: The Aging Voice*.
