🎵 Saunder Choi

Saunder Choi (he/him) is an award-winning Filipino-Chinese composer and choral artist whose work centers identity, place, and shared human experience. Recipient of the 2024 ACDA Raymond W. Brock Prize for Professional Composers, his music has been performed internationally by leading choirs such as the Philippine Madrigal Singers, Los Angeles Master Chorale, Pacific Chorale, and others. As an arranger, he's written for Lea Salonga, GMCLA, San Francisco Symphony, and others. He sings with Pacific Chorale, L.A. Choral Lab, and HEX Vocal Ensemble, as well as in major film

scores. Saunder is the Director of Music at the UU Church of Santa Monica and a teaching artist with the Los Angeles Master Chorale.

🎵 Susanne Maziarz

Susanne Maziarz (she/her) has been the Music Director at Neighbourhood Unitarian Universalist Congregation in Toronto since 2007. She directs and accompanies Neighbourhood's Spirit Choir and Spirit Band; leads the Comfort Choir that sings at bedside in Palliative care; co-leads a monthly Circle Song sessions and open mic; and sings with Sumudna, a BIPOC-led community protest choir for collective liberation. She has been the Music Director for the CUC's National Conference three times and served on the Silliman Hymn Competition team as well as having her original compositions and arrangements included in the AUUMM choral reading packets.

Dr. Baker L. Purdon (he/they) is an award-winning conductor and music educator currently serving as the Director of Music Ministry at Jefferson Unitarian Church in Golden, CO.

With experience spanning many faith traditions and nearly a decade of teaching in both public and private schools, he gained national recognition for his debut choral album *Walking Through the Valley: Choral Music from Black Composers, 1919-2022*, which featured the first commercial recordings of works by Harry T. Burleigh, Adolphus Hailstork, and Margaret Bonds.
