Accessible space. Seating available.

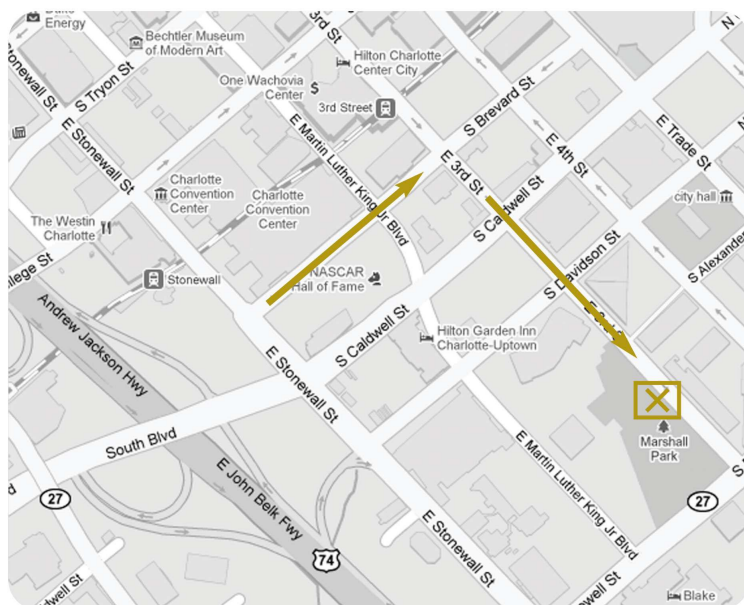
