Mr. Brennan was named Treasurer and Chief Financial Officer of the Unitarian Universalist Association of Congregations by the Board of Trustees at their June 2006 meeting. In addition to overseeing the Department of Finance, he supervises the UUA's internal service offices, including the General Assembly, Information Technology Services, and Operations staff groups.
