

SABBATICAL COMMITTEE

The purpose of the Sabbatical Committee, working together with the minister, will be

(a) to oversee the preparations for the minister's sabbatical before the sabbatical begins. This would include communicating with the congregation about the sabbatical plans including newsletter articles, a brochure, and perhaps an open forum. The final sabbatical plans – both for the minister's sabbatical itself and for the replacement plans in his absence -- must be approved by the Board of Trustees.

(b) to monitor and support the staff, church Board and others to see that the sabbatical replacement plans are proceeding and are adequate while the minister is away;

(c) to help welcome back the minister after the sabbatical and to assist with the minister's re-entry and re-engagement with the life of the congregation.

The committee will number between 5 - 8 people to be chosen by the minister.
