VOTE

DELEGATES

Delegates are selected members and qualifying religious professionals of certified congregations. Congregations decide how to select their member delegates and may choose to instruct their delegates how to vote.

CREDENTIALS

After March 1, congregational officials may access credential documents at my.uua.org to assign and distribute them to members selected as delegates.

VOTE IN PERSON - GA IN NEW ORLEANS

On June 24, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm CT, delegates may scan their GA name badge at voting kiosks in the Great Hall Lobby of the New Orleans Convention Center to vote.

VOTE ABSENTEE - ONLINE

From June 1, 9:00 am to June 24, 5:00 pm CT, delegates unable to vote in person may access their election ballot by following the voting link found on their delegate credential document.

VOTE ABSENTEE - MAIL

Delegates unable to vote in person or online may request a paper ballot by mail at UUA General Assembly, 24 Farnsworth Street, Boston, MA 02210. Requests must include a copy of the delegate credential document and be postmarked by June 1. Completed ballots must be received by June 14 or postmarked by June 12.
