Step 1 – Brainstorm all the images you can think of that relate you your story, theme, or idea. No judgement, no censoring. Fill as many bubbles as you can.

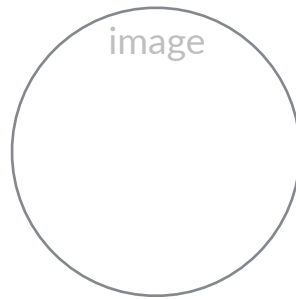
A grid of 18 empty circles arranged in four columns and five rows. The circles are intended for students to draw images related to their story, theme, or idea.
