

Become a Chalice Lighter

The Northern New England District Chalice Lighter grant program is committed to maintaining and expanding the capacity of UU congregations in Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont to meet the needs of members, potential members and the communities they serve.

A high priority is placed on congregations that are either expanding programs or ministries, or making critical renovations to make their spaces more accessible and sustainable.

Almost all grant funds come from individual UUs throughout the region who commit to contributing when a “call” is sent during the year. Calls for support identify the specific projects to be funded.

In recent years Chalice Lighter donors have helped to fund expanded professional help, new programs for growth, and building improvements for access and for program expansion.

A Chalice Lighter . . .

responds to two calls for help during the year with a donation of \$25 or more to help a congregation in Northern New England District do more and reach more people.

Chalice Lighters help congregations increase access or expand facilities, including improving energy efficiency.



Chalice Lighters help growth programs get off the ground.
