Level	Title and Number of Sessions	Theme	Content
Multigenerational	Circle of Trees 8 sessions	Earth stewardship with a focus on trees	This program focuses on connecting deeply with trees, nature, and all of earth's living creatures. Trees are seen as a symbol of life on earth (for example, the Tree of Life) and are commonly understood to be sustainers of life on the planet by even young children.
Multigenerational	Gather the Spirit 8 sessions	Earth stewardship, with a focus on water.	Through a lens both scientific and religious, this program addresses the importance of water, the inequity of access to clean water, and actions we can take as Unitarian Universalist stewards to preserve water and water rights.
Multigenerational	Wisdom from the Jewish Scriptures 8 sessions	Understanding stories from the Hebrew scriptures, and their meanings for us today.	The program asks not only "what happened?" but also "what did it mean for the people of the time?" It asks not only, "What does this story mean in our contemporary lives?" but also, "How does it challenge us spiritually and what wisdom does it offer?" For older children, youth and adults.
Multiage	Miracles 8 sessions	Participants create and observe physical transformations that, even when predictable, may strike us as miraculous. They explore miraculous, intangible transformations of human spirit.	The program provides a prolonged encounter with awe and wonder with frequent opportunities for scientific exploration. Through stories from our Unitarian Universalist Sources and hands-on activities, children engage in defining and discerning the miraculous and discover their own agency for miracle-making.
