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## How to Remember Us in Your Will

Creating a bequest is easy and as simple as adding a sentence or two to your will. Regardless of the amount, your bequest is a statement of faith, and if you demonstrate that you care enough about Unitarian Universalism to support its future, others will follow your example. Below is suggested language you can use to draft your bequest.

### UNRESTRICTED GIFT

I give to the Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) (tax I.D. number 04-2103733), a nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation, located in Boston, Mass., [\_\_\_\_\_ percent of my estate or the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ ] for its general purposes.
