

Youth Leadership Grant

Congregational support is vital to developing youth leadership. In order to support congregational youth leadership development, the Youth Leadership Grants will match contributions from a congregation, covenanted community, or related organization up to \$300. Youth must include a letter of endorsement from the minister, president, or treasurer of the UU congregation, covenanted community, or related organization.

Youth Leadership Grants can be used for a variety of opportunities from UU College of Social Justice events, service trips with the UUSC or the UUA's International Office, regional/district trainings, camps and conferences, General Assembly and more!

Youth Leadership Grants will be disbursed on a rolling basis, so you can apply at any time. Youth Leadership grants are capped at a maximum disbursement of \$300.

Criteria

To qualify for the Youth Leadership Grant, you must be affiliated or in relation with a member congregation, covenanted community, or related organization of the UUA.

Funding for these grants is provided by the generosity of our UUA member congregations via the Annual Program Fund or GIFT Program (www.uua.org/amplify).
